 Account for the produce of the said wynes and make satisfaction to the Compt^t for the
 produce thereof wth Damages for dead Freight and other unjust detaining the same
 and that the Defend^t might upon his Oath true Answer make to all & singular the
 p^rmisses and that the Compt^t might be Relieved therein according to Equity he humbly
 Craved the favorable oye & assistance of this Honorable Court. and that p^rovise of
 Subpoena. might be therout awarded to appear in the said Court and Answer
 the p^rmisses. The which being granted and the said Defend^t therewithall served
 He appeared accordingly. And putt in his Answer to the said Bill. And theroby
 did sett forth that the said Ketch Coming to Anchor in youke Riv^r in Virginia
 The master therof Boone did Invite the Defend^t on board and desired the
 Defend^t to pilot him up Potomack Riv^r the Defend^t refusing to go to Patuxent
 wher he did and Boone paid him for the same. And Coming to an Anchor
 near St Georges Island in Maryland. The Compt^t Received Advice that One Raymond
 Stapleford had a Judgment against him wher made the Compt^t unwilling to go
 to Patuxent. But he Came and agreed wth the Defend^t. to Receive & sell
 the said wynes wher he pretended was in partnership between him & nothing
 And then gave the Defend^t a power to that Effect. wth promise to allow my
 him seven and a halfe p^r cento. for sale & selliradge and Assisting. to Ret^r
 Debt. And further to allow unto the Defend^t all other necessary Charges wh^{ch}
 he should be at about the said wynes. And the next day following the p^rt
 had Advice from some merchants and planters that there were Cutyne persons
 Coming to call him to account for some Bayles of Silke Carried by the p^rt
 from New England to Bilbao in Spayne. so that he the said p^rt gave the
 Defend^t Another Order writt with his own hand to this Effect. (vizt) —
 Capt Noale in John Methway of Hyall hath shipped on Board in the Hope
 =well of London Andrew Boone Master Twenty Tons of Hyall wynes in p^rpp^r
 Barrells of Hogshoad w^{ch} by the bill of Lading you may see who Consigned them
 to mee but verbally gave me order to Deliver them to you. if you were Living. Which
 I desire you to accept and make the Returnes according to Mr Methways order
 advise wher I herewith give you. And therewith the Compt^t gave the Defend^t
 Instructions writt wth the hand of the said Mr Methway but directed to the p^rt
 wher in he advised the said p^rt that he shipped aboard the said wynes Ketch
 the wyne aforesaid. and that he had disbursed for the whole Charge of the said
 wynes, w^{ch} also Two hundred Eighty six millrays which he sent the Compt^t to
 repayre his shipp^r provisions which he must pay to Methway wth Ten p^r cento.
 p^r cent. till the money was Repaid according to the Custome of Hyall.
 which Two p^rcent the Defend^t said were Left or unjustly taken from the
 Defend^t. Together wth a T^r and a Bill wherom the Compt^t stood
 Indebted to a Dutie man in Delaware in a Quantity of Tobacco
