and his Partners great Damage. Wherefore that the Defendant might come to a Just trial
 account for the produce of the said wynes and make satisfaction to the Comptroller for the
 product therof with Damages for dead freight and other unjust detaining the same
 and that the Defendant might upon his Oath true Answer make to all & singular the
 premises and that the Comptroller might be Relieved therefrom according to Equity he humbly
 Prayed the favorable and sufficiente of this Honorable Court. and that process of
 Subpoena. might be thereout awarded to appear in the said Court and Answer
 the premises. The which being granted and the said Defendant therunto all sworne
 he appeared accordingly. And saith in his Answer to the said Bill. And thereby
 did sett forth that the said Ketch Coming to Anthon in yorke Rul in Virginia
 the master therof Boone did invite the Defendant on board and desired the
 Defendant to pilot him up Potowmack Rul the defendant refusing to go to Patowmack
 where he did and Boone paid him for the same. And coming to an Anthon
 near St Georgey Island in Maryland the Comptroller Received to vise that One Raynolds
 Stapleford had a Judgment against him whiche made the Comptroller unwilling to go
 to Patowmack. But he came and agreed with this Defendant to Receive & sell
 the said wynes whiche he pretended was in partnership betwene him & Nethway
 And then gave the Defendant power to that effect. with promise to allow my
 him twenty and a halfe p Cento. for sale & delivery and shipping. to Recov
 Debts. And further to allow unto the Defendant all other necessary charges wh
 he should be at about the said wynes. And the next day following the gott
 had to vise from some merchant and planter that there were certaine p sons
 coming to call him to account for some Bayles of Sylke Carried by the gott
 from New England to Bilboa in Spayne so that he the said gott gave this
 Defendant another Order writt with his owne hand to this effect. (vizt)
 Capt Neale & John Nethway of ffyall hys shippes on Board in the Habor
 -well of London Andrew Boone Master Twenty Tonnes of ffyall wynes in poyson
 Barrells & Hogsheads ab by the bill of Lading you may see who Consigned them
 to me but verballly gave me order to Deliver them to you if you were listing. Wher
 I desire you to accept and make the Returns according to my Nethways order
 aduite where I sente you. And therwile the Comptroller gave thy defend
 Instructione writt with the hand of the said Mr Nethway but directed to the gott
 wherein he advised the said gott that he shippes aboard the said wyne Ketch
 the wyne aforesaid. and that he had discharged for the whole Charge of the said
 wynes. ab also Two hundred Eighty six millrys which he sent the Comptroller to
 recouer his shippes Proportion which he must pay to Nethway with ten p Cent.
 go and till the money was Recov according to the Cusome of ffyall.
 which Two payes the defendant said were lost or mislly taken from this
 Defendant. Together with a Tax and a Bill wherim the Comptroller stood
 Indebted to a Dutymen in Delaware in a Quantite of Tobacco
