Testimony of Ralph Elton found & who were summoned & appeared as Evidence
before James Murphy & Hugh Sherwood on behalf of W^m Worvilow of
Talbot County touching y^e Land called Rays Point

James Murphy & Hugh Sherwood two of his Majesty's
Justices of y^e peace for y^e County aforesaid sent in obedience
to a Commission directed to us from y^e high Court of Chancery of
this province bearing date y^e 10th day of Novemb^r 1696 in
pursuance of y^e said Commission both repaired to y^e tract of Land
called Rays Point, cont 150 Acre of Land & that upon y^e
19th day of Feb^r 1696, having afore given notice to all Par-
ties concerned therein did meet with one Ralph Elton found
who being a Quaker would not swear upon well did con-
-vict him y^e best upon well he did solemnly declare upon y^e
Land after he had brought us to y^e first bounded tree of y^e said
Land it being an old Cedar tree blown up by y^e roots y^e said
tree being within a branch of a brook called Broad brook & on the
North east side of y^e said branch, then y^e said Elton showed us y^e
where he bounded y^e second bounded tree well was as near as
could guess about 30 yards within a Cove skulking in from y^e
Easternmost branch of aforesaid Broad brook & on y^e west side
of y^e said Cove & for want of authority in our Commission did
omit of marking any tree where he showed us y^e second
bound tree was which he did affirm he marked with his
own hands & likewise y^e first bounded tree & further y^e
said Elton saith not! In witness whereunto We have hereunto
set our hands & seals y^e day & year aforesaid.
