

Deposition of Lydia Newman (alias Mannor) for
Phil Lynes

Charles County

As appeared to a Comissioner to the videlicet bearing
date the third day of June Anno 1693
the fourth year of his Majesty's reign William by the Graces of God
of England Scotland France & Ireland King & Ruler
in us to take the deposition of one Elizabeth Newman
of Charles County Widow, in perpetuum Pro Memoriam
But the Name mentioned in the Comission being mistaken
upon Examination of the said appeared to give testimony
her Name being Lydia Newman the Relique of George
Newman late of Charles County deceased And now Lydia
Mannor by Intermarriage joined with one John Mannor
now of Charles County. Which said Lydia Newman (alias
Mannor) did take her Corporall oath upon the holy Evan-
gelist concerning a certain piece of Land lying in
Balloune County was Polappsed formerly taken up
betwixt Capt William Batten & Thomas Thomas both
formerly of this province but now both deceased Which said
Deposition was by me taken from the mouth of the said
Lydia well I have together with the Comission trans-
mitted as I am by the Comission required And the said
her oath is as underneath mentioned

August the 24 1698

Then came before me Lydia Newman (alias Mannor)
and made oath upon the holy Evangelist as touching the Land
of Comission to me directed that she knew her self
in Law me Will^m Batten & the Thomas & of the said
hear them both say if they had taken up a certain Tract
of Land consisting as she heard them say about one thousand
Land Acres or thereabouts lying near about Polappsed
in Balloune County And if she had both parties say if
longest lived should take all the said Tract of Land & if
Thomas first deceasing & his Widow Thomas leaving
living and long after And if the Widow Thomas leaving
my father in Law Will^m Batten was dead come over to her
Mother Mrs. Mary Batten requesting her to give her
right & title of the aforesaid Tract of Land if she might
feel her son Thomas the well me Batten refused to do And
further this Deposition faith and Robert Yates
