 some wordes Hemfly said he must submit because I must be beholde to y^e
 for living here y^e lines takeing away soe much of my Plantation & as they
 were running y^e line w^{ch} came through Capt Hemfly's Orchard Collyer
 Pluckt an Apple of one of y^e Trees & brought to y^e House Capt Hemfly's
 Wife began to scalle & shoute y^e Collyer desired her Patience saying he came
 there for any such purpose but asked her to eat an Apple out of his Orchard
 w^{ch} caused her to continue her Raileoury till Capt Hemfly spoke to her saying
 Prithce Judith be quiet we shall be forced to be beholde to y^e Collyer for we
 can't live here but by his favour & permission & are as it were but Tennants
 because we can't employ our servants on y^e Plantation without his leave There
 Collyer told Capt Hemfly he might use any part of y^e Plantation provided
 he should not be molested during his life only required an acknowledgement
 of y^e Right that was in him to such a part of y^e Plantation as y^e lines of
 Resurvey took on saying y^e acknowledgement should be two Apples of y^e Orchard
 Capt Hemfly seeing howe little land was like to be left between y^e lines of
 Resurvey used this Expression Pray for leave me but as much land as will serve
 me for a burying Place I am Contented and thereupon y^e Collyer gave him
 land & said y^e as they had been the Neighbours so they would continue Neighbours
 still & would not hinder him from making use of any part of y^e Plantation
 during his life only required y^e acknowledgement as and thereupon y^e Capt
 Hemfly accepted of & assented to y^e Proposalls of y^e Collyer & this Deponent
 upon further Collection of his Memory doth remember y^e Hemfly himself
 set y^e Course first & after that y^e Surveyor & that they both agreed exactly
 & further y^e Deponent saith not
