The S^d Bill way directed
 to m^r James Brown at
 ye City of St Maries
 Sept 3, 1698

Came John Stanley & made oath upon ye holy Evangelist
 that he with ye within Writing & of his saw m^r Doulton
 sign ye same with his own hand-writing & of his knows
 ye m^r Henry Doulton did agree to sell his house & two Cellar
 St Maries to James Brown for twenty pounds ster & a
 silver Standard of five pounds ster
 Sworn before me Hen Jewels Chancell

Sept 12th 1698

Therefore this Cause coming this day to be heard
 upon bill & answer in ye presence of ye Councill
 on both sides, Upon reading ye bill & answer & ye
 deposition of John Stanley taken in this Cause by ye Cou
 -ourt of Commissioners referred to ye Judgment of this Court It is
 hereby ordered & Decreed That ye Coupl^t James Brown
 do hold & enjoy ye Land houses & premises in ye Coupl^t bill
 mentioned according to ye true intent & meaning of the
 Agreement between him ye m^r James Brown & Henry Dou
 lon proved & admitted by ye m^r Doulton to him ye m^r James
 Brown his heirs & Assignes forever as ye m^r Henry Doulton
 his heirs & as ye m^r Mary ye Relict of ye m^r Henry her Right
 of Doulton to ye same which to him & by this Court Decreed
 accordingly the ye m^r James Brown first paying or securing to
 be paid to ye m^r Mary Doulton & Rachel Doulton ye purchase
 Money & plate in ye bill & answer mentioned according to ye
 Law of this Province both provide if it to say, one third part
 thereof to ye m^r Mary in Discharge of her part & ye other two
 thirds to be secured to ye ye of ye m^r Rachel in ye account
 of her Administration of ye m^r Henry Doulton Estate by ye
 Judge of ye Court for probat of Wills & And ye rest & charges
 of this side by ye Consent of ye parties to be born & paid in
 equal
