

And it having been supposed that a Red Oak Standing on the Right Hand
of the aforesaid Road that goeth from the W^m Hutchison to Cicattawa
Creek aforesaid about fifty p^{ch}. Near the said Hutchison house at y^e h^o
of a small Valley close by the said Road the said tree being burnt to a
Stump the said Stump being supposed to have been a bound tree of Thomas
Charles which the said George Althoa coming to and having taken his Oath
did declare the same to be the first bound tree of Cap^t Zachariah W^m
Land and none of the trees of the said Thomas' chance all which y^e said
George Althoa did declare before us in presence of M^r Elizth Hawkins Owner
of the Land called Locust, Duckett and of W^m Hutchison having Land adjacent
therunto and Others of Neighbourhood; As Witness my hand and
