

State. And not to charge the said John Balley with any bad Debt. And it
 is likewise further ordered that the said James Neale shall also pay and allow
 unto the said John Balley his Cost and Damages by him sustained by reason of this
 omission. To be set up accounted and allowed of by his Excellency Charles
 Calvert Esq. the Hon^{ble} Phillip Calvert Esq. Chancellor and the Hon^{ble}
 William Calvert Esq. or any two of them. And what they or any two
 of them shall so set up compute and allow to be paid by the said James
 Neale to the said John Balley for his Cost and Damages aforesaid.
 It is hereby further ordered and directed that the same shall stand
 Ratiſfyed and Confirmed by the Verdict of this Court to all intents & pur-
 = poses without any Appeals from the same or Repalls thereof. And
 the same is to be paid by the said James Neale unto the said John Balley
 accordingly. And in pursuance of the last Recited order his Excellency
 Charles Calvert Esq. the Hon^{ble} Phillip Calvert & William Calvert Esqs
 did in the presence of the Comptroller Balley and his Attorney (none attending
 for the defend^t Neale though due Notice was given to his Attorney) -
 peruse and examine a Vouch^r of the particular Cost and Damages paid
 to them by the said John Balley. And having seriously viewed the same
 and duly considered thereof did think fitt and so order. That the
 said John Balley be allowed for his Cost and Charges expended in
 this cause. The sume of Twelve thousand two hundred twenty
 nine pound of Tobacco and Calque. for Chancellors Secretarys and
 Sheriffs fees. And for his Imprisonment and other fees. And further they did order
 and allow to the said John Balley for his Damages and staying here and being
 out of his Tobacco three yeares the sume of twenty pound sterling & ans.
 which in all com^t to the sume of eight pound sterling. which in Tobacco at
 one penny 9 pound com^t to the sume of ffourteen thousand four hundred
 pound of Tobacco. Its also the sume of eight pound ster. for eighty the^t
 of Tobacco being the produce of the said w^{ny} to be paid by the said Neale
 to the said Balley for the imposition of two shillings 9 Roy^l lately laid
 upon Tobacco. the one moetye of the said eight pound ster. to be to the
 use of the said Balley and the other moetye to the use of the said Nothway
 which said sume of eight pound ster. in Tobacco at one penny 9 pound
 com^t also to the sume of ffourteen hundred & twenty 9 pound of Tobacco.
 All which said severall sumes allowed for Cost and Damages w^{ch} aforesaid
 doe in the whole amount unto the sume of twenty eight thousand
 five hundred & ffourty four pound of Tobacco. which said sume of
 twenty eight thousand five hundred & ffourty four pound of Tobacco.
