 say the five & Twentieth day of February in the ~~xxxx~~ year of the
 Dominion of Cecilus &c. Amozs Dom, 1672: By his Excellency Charles
 Calvert Esq. Chiefe Judge in equity. the Honorable Phillip Calvert Esq. Cant.
 and the rest of their Associates Justices of the said Court. And by the Power and
 Authority of the High and Honorable Court of Chancery. Ordered & Judged & Decreed
 that the said severall orders and Reports and every thing therein Contayned doe stand
 Rattified and Confirmed by this present Decree to be Observed and performed
 by all the said partyes to all intents and purposes according to the Tenor and true
 Meaning thereof. And that the said James Neale Doe forthwith pay unto the
 said John Balloy the said sume of Sixtie One Thousand five hundred & nynety
 poundes of Tobacco to him by this Court Judged Accordingly, **Wee Doe**
Therefore hereby strictly Charge and Comand you that all and every the matters
 and things in the said finall Judgement or Decree mentioned & specified & Contayned
 so farre forth as the same or any of them doe in any wayes Touch or Concern
 you You doe well & Truly Observe performe fulfill and Keepe to all Intents
 and Purposes according to the Tenor and true meaning thereof. And that you
 pay unto the Complaynant John Balloy or his Assignes the said sume of
 Sixtie one Thousand five hundred and nynety poundes of Tobacco. And this you
 are not in noe wise to Omitt under the penalty therupon enjoining Witht the
 our selfe at our City of S^t Maryes the ~~xxv~~ day of February in the ~~xxxx~~
 year of our Dominion over our said Province of Maryland. Amozs Dom, 1672
