

John Dicks of Annarundell County Planter Depoth and saith
 that he knows Samuell Galloway and Gabriell Parrott both of
 Annarundell County and was the serv. boy of Daniell Long-
 man in his life time and that his Mas^r for the first four
 or five years of his Service did use to Labour this Depo^{nt}
 and the rest of his Serv^{ts} very hard and cloth them very thin
 and Indifferent and they used to Complaine to him and he
 usually answered them to be patient till he had fully paid
 his father Parrott (to whom he was bound to pay all his
 Deb^{ts}) and then his Deb^{ts} would be his own and they should
 be better clothed which proved true for about two years
 before his M^r Masters Death he used to ship his Deb^{ts}
 himselfe for England and then he did cloth this Dep^t and the rest
 of his Serv^{ts} very well but he used to tell us that before, that he
 was bound to pay all his Deb^{ts} to his father and his M^r.
 had severall parcels of Goods come into him and some small
 time before his M^r Death he heard him say that he had
 paid all the Deb^{ts} he owed Parrott but could not gett in his
 Bonds that this Depo^t was well acquainted wth his M^r house-
 hold living of w^{ch} he had plenty and severall parcels of good-
 Sheets that this Depo^t was at his M^r Funerall and
 attended as a Serv^t and served Drink and Meat to them
 that was there but saw noe wine and verily believes and is
 well assured there was none that this Depo^t heard his
 M^r a little before his Death owe that he owed Parrott
 some money and doth know that he passed bills of Debt^{ts}
 to Parrott on Samuell Groom but knows not the exact
 Summe but has heard they were for fifty pounds Ster.
