Depo. came to Longmans and he askt him to come in and he
was then a looking over his books and papers and then told the
Depo. that Gabriele Parrott had Arrested him but was sure it
was w^t out just cause for he was not in his Debt but Parrott in
his Debt that Parrott kept his bills or bonds in his hands after
he had paid them and that he would prove for that he had
him ^{one} sum of Tab^t of his Plant^t and ^{had} Tab^t for Jo Parrott to y^d Number
of a hund^r and odd thos but Parrott had not given Credit for it nor would
deliver in his bonds but that now he was Arrested at his S^t he
was resolved to try it out and hoped to get in his bonds again
and Longman then further said that Parrott related he was not
worth any thing but that all was Parrott but that he did not Doubt
making it appear that nothing of his Estate was Parrott but all his owne and
