saith that some time about a year before his death this
Depo. came to Longmans and he Askt him to come in and he
was then a Looking over his books and papers and then told this
Depo. that Gabriel Parrott had Arrested him but was sure it
was w. out Just cause for he was not in his Debt but Parrott in
his Debt that Parrott kept his bills or bonds in his hands after
he had paid them and that he would prove for that he had
him serv. Sum. of Sab. of his Plant. and serv. Sab. for J. Parrott to y. Number
of a hund. and odd thrs but Parrott had not given Credit for it nor would
deliver in his Bonds but that now he was Arrested at his Sab.
he was resolv'd to try it out and hoped to get in his Bonds againe
and Longman then further said that Parrott related he was not
worth any thing but that all was Parrotts but that hee did not Doubt
making it appear that Nothing of his Estate was Parrotts but all his owne and
that he owed Nothing to Parrott but Parrott owed him This Depo. saith that he was
