

Eliz: Lockwood will if need requires give my Evidence as follows

That Dan Longman of West River being taken wth Convulsion fits one of his Servants came over to our house Desiring me to go over to his Master accordingly I went and found wth fits as aforesd. I immediately sent up to Gabriell Parrotts to lett him know how bad Longman was and towards night came Downe Gabriell Jun^r and Susana Parrott and to my Certain knowledge they brought Nothing wth them but a small Vjoll or little round bottle of Brandy and about 4 or 5 Spoonfulls of Sugar and about as much Oatmeal and some small Matter of Spice: thus to my Certain Remembrance was all that the aforesd Gabriell and Susana brought downe wth them the man Remaining unbindable all the time they were there untill he Departed w^{ch} was about 16 or 18 Hours after I came there the man being Dead. I desired Susana to look out such thing as was convenient to lay y^e Corps out wth. She replied she was not acquainted where y^e Linnin lay and desired me to do it and at her request I took y^e keys and unlocked the Chest where y^e Linnin lay and took out things convenient to lay y^e Corps out with and when we had Shifted the Corps w^{as} removed it to a large Linn Chest and then returned to that very Chest I had the Linn offt of aforesd and wth my own hands took out of that very Chest and from amongst the aforesd Linn one large fine Sheet and laid it Double over the Corps and this I am ready to Testify if need requires as witness my hand this 26 of Jan. the 9. Month 1699
