Deposition about the bounds of Land for Robert Tylor of George's County  
By virtue of a Comitt from the High Court of Chancery to us directed bearing date  
the 14 day of Decr 1700 Comanding us therein to call before us the persons of the said  
Tylor & thereupon the corporate oath of the said Tylor to take such deposition as the said  
Ninian Beal shall upon such oath by us to be administered make concerning the north  
east bounded tract of the said Tylor's manour & also touching the first bounded  
tract of a tract of Land called Darnely Grove in Pleasant Sto  
weh Comitt of the said Ninian Beal did in his own proper person  
on the 13th day of Janr 1700 come before us and having his  
oath administered by us did by laying his hand upon the said oath  
then upon the holy Evangelist on the said oath depose as followeth  
That a good oak standing on the west side of a branch called  
Collington on the south side of a branch the corner of the  
said branch called Collington is the north east corner of the  
said Ball's manour & the first bounded tract of Land  
called Darnely Grove. And the said Ninian Beal doth on his oath  
further depose That at the first surveying of the said Land for the  
said Ball by the said Ninian Beal did bound the said good oak  
as aforesaid to be the north east corner of the said Land
