Attorney his act and deed.

March the 6th 1674 Sworne before me Wm. Stevens

Memorandum that the said William Stevens in Open Court here do wit the fifteenth day of
April in the 42nd year of the Dominion of Ceciliæ & Johanna his Bath that the said Robert
Pitt and James Weedon tooke the Oath above said before him the day and year aforesaid

Ordered that Daniel Fenster pay unto the said William Stevens the full quantity
of 1000 hundred pounds of tobacco. For his coming going and attendance to
Leslie as aforesaid.

Know all men by these presents that I Charles Scarburgh of the County of Northampton
as Attorney in the Colony of Virginia Gent the Attorney Agent or factor of Henry
Scarburgh of Morwallham in the County of Norfolk in the Kingdom of England by
himselfe authorized and appointed and in my place and stead as Attorney aforesaid but
to the further use and behoufe of the said Henry Scarburgh have putt and constituted Daniel
Jennifer of the Province of Maryland Gent my true and lawfull Attorney for him the
said Henry Scarburgh and in his name to take Recouer and receive all and
every debts Duties summe and summes of mony goods wares Merchandise due owing
or belonging unto him the said Henry Scarburgh from any person or persons whatsoever
in Virginia or Maryland by bill bond specialty booke account reckoning contract or
otherwise howsoever and generally to doe manage and performe execute and order all
and every the affaires of the said Henry Scarburgh and brought within Virginia and
Maryland aforesaid in as ample and full manner to all intents and purposed as either
to my selfe or the said Henry Scarburgh might or may doe being personally present and upon
receipt of the premises or any part thereof acquittance or any other discharge therfrom
do make seal and deliver and all and every or any the debtors or debtors of the
premises or any part thereof to take and cause to be arrested attidied sued impledled imprisoned
condemned and prosecuted as fully as Law will permitt and any Attorney or Attorneys to make and
substitute and at pleasure to revoke the same againe and generally to doe and execute all and every
other act and acts thing and things needfull in or about the premises or any part
thereof as fully and effectually to all intents and purposed as to my selfe or the said
Henry Scarburgh might or may doe being personally present And I doe hereby give
and grant unto my said Attorney or Deputy as full power streight and lawfull
authority touching the premises as to my selfe have in and by One Letter of Attorney
from the said Henry Scarburgh bearing date the 16th day of October One thousand
six hundred Sixty eight hereby commanding and allowing unto my said Deputy or Attorney upon
Demand all such tobacco or other disbursements as he shall make or expend in or
about the same for the premises but more especially for all Officers fees and other
disbursements lawfully expended by my said Deputant in and about One cause depending
in the Admiralty of Maryland on behalfe of the said Henry Scarburgh against the
estate of John Doateman deceased hereby ratifying allowing and confirming all
whatsoever my said Attorney or Deputy shall doe or cause to be done in or about
the premises or any part thereof by these presents In witness whereof I the said
Charles Scarburgh and the Attorney and Agent of the abovesigned Henry Scarburgh
have hereunto set my hand and seal in the margin hereof this first day of
April One thousand six hundred Seventy One.
