obtained by Tho<sup>s</sup> Jones vs Gulstake in his s<sup>d</sup> Bill vs s<sup>d</sup> Smith  
& the s<sup>d</sup> Leagus thereupon executed contrary to all Equity & good  
Confidence upon the writings for which Bill & yo<sup>r</sup> Answer sheweth &  
hearing the Readings on both sides for that it appeared that s<sup>d</sup>  
said 4000 <sup>l</sup> was unjustly exacted from the s<sup>d</sup> by the said  
Tho<sup>s</sup> Jones in his lifetime. We do therefore declare that you the  
said Martha do pay to the s<sup>d</sup> Leagus Riggon out of the Estate of the  
s<sup>d</sup> Tho<sup>s</sup> Jones dec. in yo<sup>r</sup> hands remaining as well the sum of 4000 <sup>l</sup>  
as his general Costs by him ~~paid~~ in this behalf expended amounting  
to the sum of 2096 <sup>l</sup> 10 <sup>s</sup> 6 <sup>d</sup> <sup>plus</sup> the costs of the s<sup>d</sup> Leagus Riggon  
argued before the Hon<sup>ble</sup> Judges of the s<sup>d</sup> Court the day of 1<sup>st</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> year of our s<sup>d</sup>  
Anne Dec<sup>r</sup> 1705.
