 of Calvert County being indebted to ye said James Hoigh & Jacob Stalling in ye sum of thirty one pounds five shillings  
 three pence passed bills of exchange for ye said sum of thirty one pounds five shillings three pence  
 and ye said Stalling being also indebted to ye said James Hoigh & Jacob Stalling in ye sum of sixty five pounds  
 six shillings being also indebted to ye said James Hoigh & Jacob Stalling in ye sum of three pounds  
 six shillings (ye bill of exchange) all his personal estate goods chattels &c. for their security for  
 some smaller Debt notes (ye said) to ye said James Hoigh & Jacob Stalling by ye confession of ye said Hoigh all  
 knowledgments of ye said Leach & Jacob Stalling & by ye confession of ye said Hoigh all  
 papers & appraisals in this Court in answer to ye said bill of Complaint it does ap-  
 pear that ye said Stalling intended to assign ye Complaint of their just Debt of
