To 16th saith that the d. Dansey promised to meet the d. Robert at his Office at a tower Hill near Spiny Point and clear him and that the d. Robert did deliver the d. Dansey his Clearance from Virginia and the Lord Balltomads Officer.

To 18th saith that the said Dansey refused to clear the d. Ship Rogers pretending he wanted Security for certain Bills of Exch. he had recd & negotiated a considerable time before in full Satisfaction for the d. Ship Rogers after Condemnation.

John Slye aged about 62 years being sworn on the Holy Evangelist deposed and saith that.

To the first Juro. That he knows the Defend. and further saith not.

To 2nd That he knows the Ship Rogers and further saith not.

To 3rd That he hath heard the Ship Rogers was Condemned by a Court of Vice-Admiralty and further saith not.

To 4th That after Condemnation the Ship Rogers with all her Gunns &c. was appraised to three hundred thirty seven pounds Eleven Shillings & four pence.

To 5th That he hath been informed that Sr. John Rogers Barronet of Lynnhall in the Kingdom of England was Sole Owner of the said Ship and a certain Abraham Robert M^r.

To 6th That John Dansey the Defend. informed his Dep. that he undertook the full disposal of the d. Ship Rogers by Order of the Court of Admiralty.
