2. Q. 2nd. Do you know of any sale made by John Dansey Esq. (Master of the ship Rogers) after she was condemned to whom was the said sale made, how much did he sell her for, how was the same paid or to be paid, was not Stephen Harvey & John Rogers to give Bills with good Country Security for the payment of the said ship before the same was to be sold into them, who advised them w<sup>ch</sup> giving security, do you know, have you heard the said John Dansey offer according to agreement made between them did you ever hear the said factors or any other concerned for the said John Rogers declare the occasion for not giving the said security, what do you believe to be the reason or interest in the doing all thereof what was the substance of the said proposals, did you ever take any deposition of any then present at the said proposals, knowing what they knew of the same, is this that is now shew'd to you the truth of what Douglas swears? Declare y<sup>r</sup> Cause of knowledge hear say & belief in the premises fully and at large.

3. Q. 3rd. Do you know or have you heard any Bills w<sup>ch</sup> were passed to the said John Dansey Esq. by the said factors for the redemption of the said ship was protested, what do you know or believe to be the reason, do you know or have you heard any Bills were paid again, do you know that the said ship was registered after condemnation as if it was a ship condemned thought a good bottom and qualified to take any loading on board by any Officers concerned in her Master's Customs without a new Reg<sup>t</sup> & Navigation Bond being first given, declare y<sup>r</sup> Cause of knowledge hear say & belief in the premises fully and at large.

4. Q. 4th. Do you know any thing material or essential for the said John Dansey the Defendant, the color to make his defence at the Suite of the said John Rogers touching the said ship Rogers?
