 fore in his said Bill Complain^t of & desire Relief in Equity ag^t y^e
 fraud of y^e said Edw Therefore upon a full hearing of y^e
 said Complain^t to Bill & of y^e said Edw's Answer & of y^e Depositions
 filed thereon & of y^e Debate of y^e Council as well for y^e said Edw as y^e
