John Wright vs: Snodden debts

The parties Complainant and debts appearing and this cause coming to a hearing in the presence of the Attorneys on both sides and the bill and supplication of the Compt and the debts and several other papers touching the same were openly read and heard and by the Court considered off and the Court is fully satisfied that the patent granted the debt Wright for six hundred and forty acres of land called Bingley in the Compt bill of complaint mentioned ought to be delivered up cancelled and made void upon record, And doe hereby Order and decree that the said patent for the said parcel of land called Bingley be delivered up by the said John Wright and cancelled admitted and be called upon record, and that the debt of three thousand pounds of Tobacco for his costs in this behalf laid out and also that the said Richard Snodden repay to the Complainant the Summe of three thousand pounds of Tobacco.

Command was given to the Sheriff of st Maries County that by good and lawful men of his Bailiwick he make known unto John Nicholls that he be and appear before his Lotts justices the 14th day of April last past to show cause if any he had why the Letters patent of a parcel of land called Tankersy or Wickes handyeck containing 350 Acres to him granted should not be vacated upon record and patent of confirmation for the same be granted to William Pritchett Sonne and heire of John Pritchett deceased and the said Sheriff saith that he hath made known to the said John Nicholls that he be and appear at the day aforesaid but the said John Nicholls came not but made default, day was then given him untill this Court but the said John Nicholls came not therefore Ordered and decreed by the Court here that the aforesaid Letters patent of the said Lord Proprietary shall be revoked cancelled evacuated admitted and for void & invalid had and obtained and also that the involvement of record of them shall be cancelled and admitted and for void and invalid had and obtained, and that patent of confirmation thereof be granted to William the son and heire of the said John Pritchett
