She being duly Examined and Sworne on the holy Evangelist of Almighty
God swith that some time in the year of our Lord One Thousand Six hundred
and Ninety Five being at the Towne of Annapolis was acquainted with a
Certaine Elizabeth proctor who then lived there: And having some discourse
with her concerning a Lott of Land in the said Towne understood by her that
She had taken up the said Lott according to Law where on now stande the
large dwelling house of which Margrett Freeman together with her husband
John Freeman since deceased built: and this Depose further swith that
She then agreed with the sd Elizabeth for the Moyety of the said Lott: But
making noe deeds of Conveyance the said Elizabeth soon after sold
the same to the said Margrett who afterwards as this Depose was informed
together with the said Margrett took up the same in their proper names
