 Court finding it Absoltely necessary for better discovery of the Equity  
 of the matter to Issue Commission for examining such Evidence on both  
 sides that might be produced by either party whereupon it was ordered that  
 Comissions Issue for Examining of the Evidence that might be produced  
 on behalfe of the Compt. And that the several Depositions that might  
 be taken shoud be transmitted into this Hono: Court by all Convenient  
 Speed. Then after whic: Commission was granted to Mr R. Highmore  
 for that purpose. And therewith was sent several Interrogatories to  
 be proposed to such Evidence at. Who soon after transmitted the several  
 Depositions by him taken into this Hono: Court which was here read and  
 followed in these words
