Mr. Russell would have had me assisted to steele her Sails and
rigging saying that they were pretty good and that a penny might
be made of them; but I refused and they were not stolne
All whis several Answers and Depositions as well on behalfe of
the Comptn as on behalfe of the Defendant were severally made
Oaths to before Mr. Richard Highman by virtue of Commission granted
to him for that purpose as aforesaid

Upon whis it was ordered that the aforesaid Bill and Answer be read a
gaine and that the foregoing Depositions already published be read
whis accordingly was read and heard and by the Court fully understood
and the agreements on both sides being fully traversed and debated
by their Committ and fully Argued as well on behalfe of the
Comptn as the Defendant - The Court here find that the Depositions
of the Comptn is of great weight and that the Comptn ought to have
relief in this Hnd Court
