It is humbly certified in Obedience to her Majesty's Commission to us Richard Henry Charles Greenberry and Thomas Larkin or any two of us Directed to Examine Evidences in perpetuum rei memoriam of and Concerning a Certain Cause thers Depositions Between Matthew Beard Complainant and Madicai Moore Defend^t as also what Witnesses by either party should be nominated and produced relating thers to but the Complainant being called produced none to be Examined on his part Whereupon We proceeded in presence of the Said Complainant to take the Depositions on part of the Defendant being severally first sworn to the severall Interrogatories following Viz^t And: ---

First of George Green of [County] ---

1st July Did you know Rich^d: Beard the Elder of Runterundell County. ---
To this Interrogatory he saith he did know the said Rich^d: Beard and further saith not ---

2^d July --- Did you know Thomas Rofler Elizth: Carrington and Thomas Pensthiwick all or any of them Supposed to be Evidences subscribed to the said Rich^d: Beard the Elders Will Dated the 24th of July 1675 and which of them ---
To this Interrogatory he saith he know one John Rutter but John Rofler & Elizth: Carrington he know not, or any of the name of pensthiwick, but that one Thomas Pensthiwick a Cooper he did know, but that any of them were Evidences to the Will of Richard Beard the Elder dated the 24th July 1675 he knowes not, and further he believes himself at that time to have been a Resident on the Eastons Shyre & further saith not ---

3^d July --- Did you see any of the aforesaid signs and which of them signe as Evidences to the aforesaid Will Dated as aforesaid. ---
To this Interrogatory he saith he knowes not that any of them were Evidences on the second Interrogatory and further saith not. ---

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
