I Mr Depo^t of Raphael Haywood Aged Sixty years or there
abouts Who Declares upon the Holy Evangelist that about forty years ago
the Depou^t lived near the plantation of One ~~William~~ Wm Pritchett
Who shewed him an Oaks that stood within Ten paces of the Said
Pritchetts house in an old orchard the Said Pritchett telling the Said
Depou^t that that was Chaplains bound Tree but some time afterwards
the Said Depou^t was informed the Said bound Tree was fallen Cut to pieces
and Carried away in the night and further the Depou^t saith that the
Spot of Ground he now stands on, One Simon Reade made out exchange
with this Depouent of being two hundred acres of Land the upper part
of Chapling Commonly called Cedar Branch and further this Depou^t
saith not
