

Informed him that he the said Richard was upon buying the

Rich<sup>d</sup>. Albert on the Road and that the said Rich<sup>d</sup>. told this Depou<sup>t</sup>.  
that he this Depou<sup>t</sup>. was the most material Evidence against  
him in order to Quash Mr. Hoales Bill and desired this Depou<sup>t</sup>. to  
returne home and not Swear and then he should do well enough  
with Mr. Hoales and Adderton for no other Evidence could do him  
a prejudice
