Faggetts Land and the said Swick and that his Land Ran no farther
Up the Creek aft^r which is the Spot of Land ^{that} D. Lock & M^r
Anthony Smith Lay their pretentions unto. -

hereafter be a Difference between us or our Children I desire you to take notice
and send this is the ~~Dividing Line~~ Dividing Line between Fundlog me
and took a hatchett which he had in his Leather Apron & Copied some
Copp^{ies} on a Saplin for that the Originall bounds were gone; (it being on
the spot where D. Lock and M^r Smith now Lay their pretentions) And
further the said Swick told this Dep^t that Fundlog ~~me~~ had agreed to putt
up a post at the said place and afterward the said Dep^t heard Fundlog oftⁿ
times affirm the same, I was before us Rich. Jones Jun^r &
