First. — Edm: Mian Beale did you Survey the Mannor above mentioned for my Lord Baltomore.

Ans: — Yes. — — — — —

Quest: — How came you to Survey it. — — —

Ans: — As being Surveyor of the County at that time and by special Order from my Lord Baltomore. — — — — —

Quest: — Did you at the same time as you bounded the first Tree of the said Mannor bound the above said Rod Oak whereon your hand is now laid for the North East Corner Tree of my Lord Baltomores said Mannor

Ans: — Yes at the same time with my own hands before I cut off from the said Land. — — — — —

Quest: — Ed Beale did you Run the said Mannor Round at the same time —

Ans: — No for after I had bounded the first Tree of the said Mannor I Run the first Course and bounded the second Tree of the said Mannor finding the North Course to be so Swampy & stilly thought it better Running upon Collington so went back to the first Tree and Run the Breadth of the said Mannor up to Collington and then bounded the above said Rod Oak for the North East Corner Tree of the said Mannor and then Run West Eight hundred paces to a Rod Oak which I then bounded for the North West Corner Tree of the said Mannor. — — — — —
