Aⁿ By my Lord Baltmore's Order to Ed: Pry and William Hutchinson that was ordered by my Lord Baltmore to Lay out a Thousand Acres of Land at ^{my} ~~the~~ ^{the} said Manner for the said Pry and the said Hutchinson began by the order of the said Pry and did bound a small white Oak within three or four foot of the above said Red Oaks standing to the Northward of the same for the Beginning Tree of the said Pry's thousand Acres of Land and from that Oaks made this Survey.

Q^y Ed Beale did you begin any other Survey upon the above said Red Oaks.

Aⁿ Yes, by Order of Ed Henry Darnall a Tract of Land called Darnalls Grove ^{the} I began at the above said Bounded Red Oaks and from the same Run West Eight hundred perches with the said Manner to another Bounded Red Oaks for ^{the} North West Corner Tree of this Lordships said Manner which said Tract of Land called Darnalls Grove I have since had in Exchange of the said Darnall for a Tract of Land called the Woodyard whereon the son of the said Darnall now lives. ---

Also the same day ~~came~~ ^{the} ~~above said~~ ^{the} ~~Ed Beale~~ ^{Ed Beale} went in the presence of James Moberly Thomas Mullikin and Charles Walker to a bounded Red Oaks standing to the ~~Westward~~ ^{Eastward} near a plantation lately Sealed by Clippaz Prygg and near to which is a white Oak Slipped on four sides and having his Oak administered by us the said Prygg and Cagott did declare that he the said Beale did bound at the first Laying out of the above said Manner a Red Oak which stood within Twenty yards of the above said bounded Red Oaks for the North West ~~Corner~~ ^{Corner} Tree of the said Manner and also bounded a Tract of Land called Darnalls Grove on the same Tree for the second Tree of the said Darnalls Grove. ---

Also the same day and time came Mr Thomas Cole before the said Prygg and Cagott and having his Oak administered by us did declare that being in Company with one Mr William Hutchinson at the Request of the said Hutchinson about seven years past in the woods Ed Beale being present and then Pointed by the said Hutchinson to the place where the North West Corner Tree of the said Manner did formerly stand he the said Thomas Cole did then hear the said Hutchinson say
