Interrogatory put to George Simons of Stamford. Esq.
the 28th June 1711. —

1st Interrogatory After what manner and how the Coupl^t came to purchase the pretended
Tract of Land called Gadsbill. —

To which he saith he cannot Tell for that the Coupl^t Agreed with
his wife. —

2^d — What did the Coupl^t Really and Bonafide pay for the same To —
which he answers he sold his Right for one hundred Acres of Land
in Baltimore County for which he Recd ~~one~~ fifteen pounds Sterl^d
of Mr Richard Odour a Merch^t & further saith not. —

3^d — Whether the same Tract of Land called Gadsbill was not purchased
by the Coupl^t of their Land, or no Land, Title or no Title —

To which he answers the Coupl^t might goe bugil of the heir,
for that he know of no ^{right} he had to any such Land & thereupon the
Coupl^t offered one hundred Acres of Land in Baltimore County for his Right.

4th — How and after what manner he came to gett you & your wife to secure
the same by Warranty. —

To which he answers he knoweth not. —

5th — What Charge Trouble and Labour have you been at to cause the Coupl^t
