Aged Sixty Year or thereabouts who being Deposed on the holy Evangelist Declares as followeth that about forty Year agoe (C<sup>o</sup> Francis Maudou an Adverser in the parts shewd him the said Dep<sup>o</sup> a bound Red Oak and said that he the said Maudou did take the said bound Tree to be one of the bound Trees of Valentines Huddestons Land and further the said Dep<sup>o</sup> said that about fourteen Years agoe he the said Dep<sup>o</sup> M<sup>r</sup> Tho. Tasker was talking concerning the bound of Valentines Huddestons Land called Ward Travele and he the said Dep<sup>o</sup> said to the said Tasker that there was a bound Tree stood in the woods up some distance from the Church which M<sup>r</sup> Maudou told him the said Dep<sup>o</sup> that he the said Maudou did take for one of the Trees of Valentines Land and M<sup>r</sup> Tasker made ans<sup>r</sup> and said yes to be sure that that is one of the bound Trees of his the said Taskers Land which the said Tasker was the buyer and purchaser of the said Tract of Land called Ward Travele laid out for the said Huddestons and William Herbert all this Deposed all the said bound Tree standing near James Mackalls plantation and farther South not sworn before us this 28<sup>th</sup> day of May 1711

That by Virtue of a Commission out of the high Court of Chancery sheweth Inclosed Directed to M<sup>r</sup> Thomas Ragott Doct<sup>r</sup> Patrick Hopburn Gent. reporting us Comiss<sup>r</sup> to Exam<sup>r</sup> Evidences touching their knowledge and Remembrance touching the bounds of a Tract of Land called the school farm formerly lying in Calvert County now in ~~Prince Georges~~ this County formerly laid out for Francis Tompson in obedience to which Commission having al the oaths of Thomas Hodsworth of Calvert County Gent. called before us this day (Ed: Amian Beale upon the first Tract of
