 pounds of Tobacco together with two thousand five hundred fifty three
 pounds of Tobacco for itinerant charges in twelve yeres time expended
 by the said Executor -

Which being read & heard it is this day to wit the thirteenth day of
 October in the 43th year of his Majesties Dominion of Anno Domini
 1674 considered by the Court here that execution be granted accord-
 =ing to the above said Order -

Scilicet to the Sheriff of Somersett County sendeth Greeting Whereas
 upon the nineteenth day of January 1663 a conditional warrant for One
 thousand acres of land issued from the Lieutenant Governour into George Nafeworthy of
 Manassas in James River in the Colony of Virginia Gent W^{ch} lay out the lands
 for him in any part of this Province provided he should make good rights for the
 same within twelve months next ensuing the date of the said Conditional warrant
 and in pursuance thereof the said George Nafeworthy had One thousand acres of
 land laid out for him in Manokin River called Nafeworthys Choice lying on
 the South side of Manokin River and whereas the said George Nafeworthy never
 made good rights for the same according to the tenor of the said warrant
 so granted to him as aforesaid whereby the said Land is become forfeited, and
 for that W^m Thompson Gent without any recital or mentioning of the said
 Conditional warrant of the said Nafeworthy hath by virtue of a patent surreptiti-
 =ously obtained from his Majesties under the Great Seals of this Province bearing
 date the first of October in the 40th year of his Majesties Dominion &c
 by him or his assigns entered into and upon five hundred acres part of the
 premises and whereas also Thomas Jones of his said County Gent by assignm^t of
 the said Nafeworthy hath also procured patent for the said One thousand
 acres of land formerly surveyed for the said Nafeworthy dated the first
 of October in the 41th year of his Majesties Dominion &c to his Majesties great
 prejudice and dishonour of him and his heirs of the premises as it is said
 and that his Majesties may have speedy right and justice in and concerning the same
 and that all and singular the said letters patents shoul^d to him the said W^m
 Thompson as the said letters patents to him the said Thomas Jones so as
 aforesaid granted may be revoked and annulled and the said lands into his
 Majesties hands as his right may be seized and the said W^m and Thomas and all
 the tenants and occupiers thereof from the possession may be removed
 doe demand the said Sheriff that by good and lawfull men of his Bailiwick
 he make knowne and give warning to the said W^m Thompson and Thomas
 Jones and all other the tenants and occupiers of the said land that they be
 before his Majesties in his Chancery the ninth day of February next to shew cause
 what for his Majesties or themselves they have or can say wherefore the said
 letters patents of the aforesaid land or any part or parcel thereof ought
 not to be revoked and annulled and the records and records thereof cancelled and
 made void and the same into his Majesties hands be seized and further to doe &c
 receive what the said Court shall doe or grant to be done in this behalf
 & that he shew returne to his Majesties justices how he hath executed this point
 Witness &c the 30th December in the 43th year &c 1674.

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
