Richard Vowles Depo: Concerning the Bounds of his Land -

In obedience to a Commission to us directed Impowering and Requiring us to call & cause to come before us all such Evidence as <sup>should</sup> be ~~by~~ <sup>by</sup> ~~him~~ <sup>him</sup> nominated & produced unto us by Richard Vowles living on St. Clements Bay in St. Mary County and to examine them and every of them on their Oath & Oaths to be by us Administered on the holy Evangelist touching their knowledges and Remembrance of the Bound of a parcel of Land belonging to the said Vowles of the said County being the dwelling plantation of the said Vowles as by the said <sup>Comiss</sup> ~~Comiss~~ dated the first day of August <sup>Anno</sup> 1711 may and doth appear We therefore at the Request of the said Vowles summoned & called before us John Wood of the said County planter who being sworn upon the holy Evangelist declares as followeth upon the place, that near the place where his Wood (being upon the side of St. Clements Bay) he know and saw a bounded Spanish Bark above forty years past, he being now about seventy years of age; and that he saw the said Bark about twenty years past standing on the side of St. Clements Bay upon a narrow Bay Bank near a small Cove or Cove and that the said Tree was since washed into the Bay and that he knew the said Tree to be the Bound of two Spanish Tracts of Land the one called Red Bank the other the now dwelling plantation of the said Vowles, and the other called Rocky point and that the said two tracts of Land did formerly belong to our Richard Wood the Depo: father - We likewise at the same place and time being the date of the present Sworn Viz: Gough aged about twenty and eight years who swears that he being formerly the wife of George Woodcock dead who was possessed of a Tract of Land lying on the East side of St. Clements Bay called & known by the name of Rocky point the said George in his life time did tell this Depo: that a certain Tree which formerly stood upon a ~~small~~ <sup>narrow</sup> Bay Bank near a small Cove being near the
