Thomas Wauchope's Writ of Adquod damnum returned

St. Marys County

Pursuant to a Writ of Adquod damnum out of the High Court  
of Chancery Directed to me as Sheriff of the said County Commanding that  
by the oaths of twelve good and Lawfull men of your County that you Survey  
and Lay out for Thomas Wauchope of the said County Liberty Acres of Land  
lying at the foot of my Lord Baltimore's Mill Run in the County aforesaid for  
Erecting and building a Water Mill in. Therefore pursuant to the said  
Writ we have Surveyed and laid out the said Land as follows the Beginning  
at a bounded Red Oak standing on the West Side of the main Run afe  
arly two perches distance from it in the woods thence Running North  
West fifty six perches to a bounded Red Oak thence North East fifty  
six perches to a bounded Red Oak thence East twenty seven Degrees  
Southly thirty eight perches thence East fifty degrees Southly by twenty  
perches thence with a straight Line to the first Tree containing by  
Estimation Twenty Acres more or less Valued at Twenty Shillings Sterd  
payable to my Lord Baltimore part owner of said Land and five Shillings  
Sterd to William Price owner of the other part of said Land and under the  
yearly Rent of Eighteen pence Sterd to my Lord Baltimore and Six pence  
Sterd money to William Price of Annun to each, to which we as well the  
said Sheriff and the Jury have affixt our hands and Seals this 17<sup>th</sup>

day of Sept. 1711:
