

John Cutler Depo. about the bounds of a Tract of Land called Roziers Refuge

Charles County of the white banks on the East Side of the Tobacco Creek binding upon a Marsh and on the North Side of the mouth of the Branch Jan. 1707

The oath of Nicholas Cooper aged sixty years said upwards viz as follows

The same the above said Nicholas Cooper and then and there made oath upon the holy Evangelist that about thirty seven or eight years ago or thereabouts this Depon. was one of the Chain Carriers at the Surveying and Running out of the dividing Line of a Tract of Land containing two thousand acres Between Mr. Rozier and Mr. Chandler: Roziers Refuge being the one part thereof whereon the Depon. now stands the Mr. Richard Ogden was the Surveyor and to the best of his knowledge the first Beginning Tree of the fore said Dividing Line was then a bounded white Oak stood on the place as above said whereon the Depon. now stands the at a white Oak or within a yard or two thereof there the said Survey. Begun is first Course for the Dividing Line of the said two thousand acres of Land and the foresaid Mr. Rozier and Mr. Chandler was there present and then and there mutually did agree and consent to the Running of the foresaid Dividing Line of the above said two thousand acres of Land and further this Depon. doth not as Witness the Deponents hand & Seal the day and year above written
