


Said Deponent together with Cap<sup>t</sup> James Murphy and Edward Fuller

By Virtue of a Special Warrant Issued out of the high Court of Chancery  
Dated at the City of Annapolis the Eight day of September 1711 to me  
Directed that upon a certain Cause depending in Said Court Between John  
Hall Compt<sup>r</sup> and Christopher Vernon Defend<sup>r</sup> I should Carefully Refurvoy  
and lay out two Tracts of Land in dispute Between the Compt<sup>r</sup> and  
Defend<sup>r</sup> Lying in Anne Arundell County the one called Gadhill the other  
called Marshes Seat according to the Ancient Moots and Boundes thereof  
as in the Originall Certificats thereof are Express according to the pre-  
tentions of the Compt<sup>r</sup> and Defend<sup>r</sup> -

These are therefore Humble to Certify that I have Carefully Refurvoyed  
and laid out the Lands in Question as follows and first according to the  
pretentions of the Compt<sup>r</sup> in presence of the Defend<sup>r</sup> I have Refurvoyed  
Laid out the Tract of Land called Marshes Seat and thereas the first  
bounded Tree thereof could not be found and the Compt<sup>r</sup> alleging of the  
second bounded Tree proved by the Defend<sup>r</sup> Cordons I reversed the first  
course to the Spott whereby the originall Certificate the first bounded  
Tree should stand which is described in the platt at A. From thence  
I runn North Seventy five perches to the first bounded Tree described  
in the platt at B. thence West by North three hundred & Twenty perches  
to the end of which Line is described in the platt at C. thence South  
Seventy perches the end of which line is described in the platt at D.
