 in his hands Received and that upon the whole matter such Decree may  
 be made by the Court of Chancery for the Re covering the Effects of the said  
 Trustt into the hands of the said Donmott towards discharging the said  
 Trustts Debts and distributions where by Law it may goe Wherefore  
 the said Richard prays Supra &c. And the said Arthur saith that  
 true it is the said John in his life time Employed the Defd. as a Factor  
 in Maryland to sell and dispose of several parcels of Rum Sugar Molasses  
 and Cottons an exact Account whereof and of the Sales of the same & to whom  
 is to his Audit Computed and wherein he hath given the said John Trustt  
 Credit for every thing by or from him received which Account is just & true  
 in every Article and particidar to the best of his knowledge without any  
 design to wrong the said John or his posterity of any part thereof & this  
 Defend. further sets forth and the Court might have saved himself  
 and this Defendant the trouble of a Suit in this honorable Court when  
 this Defend. was at all times ready to give a just account of the Goods  
 and that instead of being Indebted to the said John he hath been  
 paid to the Order of the said John by Bills of Exchange & otherwise  
 one hundred and six pounds Eight Shillings Sterling or thereabouts for  
 which the Estate of the said John is still Indebted to this Defend. & the said  
 Arthur Young filed with his said Oups. the Account of Sales of four  
 hogheads eight Percos and fifty pound barrels of Rum as followeth Viz<sup>t</sup>
