

At & from any port or place in Virginia or Maryland or either
 of them at the said Merchant his Factors or Assignes should order,
 & thence being dispatched should as winds & weather should permit
 (casualties & dangers of Seas Excepted) Sayle apply & trade to att & from
 London Rotterdam Amsterdam or any Ports in the West Country in England
 Soe as the said Shipp should be brought back for London in Twelve Months
 at farthest (casualties dangers of Seas & restraint of Princes Excepted)
 And that it should be lawful to & for the said Merchant his Factors or
 Assignes to employ ^{the said} Shipp & her long-boate & Skiffe during the said
 Voyage in & about the Lading relading & discharging of such Goods &
 Merchandises & in & about such usual Affairs & business as the said Merchant
 his Factors or Assignes should thinke fitt & direct And also that the said
 Master should followall such lawfull Orders & directions as he should
 from tyme to tyme receive from the said Merchant his Factors or Assignes
 touching the said Voyage And the said Merchant did thereby amongst
 other things agree & Covenant not only to virtuell & man the said
 Shipp with sufficient Provisions & Sixteen Seamen & a boy besides the said
 Master & Order the said Shipp to returne for London aforesaid there to
 end all her Monthly Employment by or before the Expiration of twelue
 Months, but also well & truly pay unto the said Master his Exor & Assignes
 for the Freight & hire of the said Shipp during the tyme she
 should be in the Service of the said Merchant Sixty five pound sterling
 p^r Month or at the same rate for a lesser tyme then a Month in manner
 & forme following, that is to say soe much thereof should be due and
 payable after the Monthly rate aforesaid at the tyme of the said
 Shipp's first Arrivall in Virginia or Maryland within ten dayes
 next after Certificate or other true notice should come to London of such
 their Arrivall there, soe much more thereof as should be due and
 payable after the Monthly rate aforesaid at the tyme of the said Shipp's
 Arrivall at the Port of deliuey in Holland within ten dayes next
 after such her Arrivall there And the residue at the discharge and
 returne of the said Shipp in the Port of London with Primage and
 Avandge accustomed And that the said Merchant his Exor & Factors or
 Assignes should pay & satisfie all Port duties due & payable for the
 said Shipp during the said Employment And to pay & discharge all
 Seamonies wages which should grow due & payable during the
 said Voyage, & thereof & therefrom save harmless & indemnified
 the said Master & the said Shipp And the said Merchant did further
 agree & Covenant to finde & provide sufficient Sloopes for the fetching
 of the tobacco in Virginia or Maryland aforesaid for the lading of the
 said Shipp at the proper Costs & Charges of the said Merchant his Factors
 or Assignes And to the performance of all & every the Covenant & Grants
 Articles Payments Provisions & Agreements in the said
 Charterparty contained by & on the behalfe of the said Merchant his
 Factors or Assignes to be holden observed performed fulfilled and
 kept in all things he bound himselfe his Exor & Assignes unto
 the said Master his Exor & Assignes in the penall Summ of One
 Thousand pound sterling well & truly to be paid by these parties
 And the Comp^r further shewed, that he did upon the said Twentysight
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
