 to all the Matters and things in this Bill set forth to make as if hereby
 particularly interrogated and to stand to and abide such Decree as your Orat.
 on a full hearing shall think fitt to make for your Orat. & I do hereby

 of the one part and this Defendant by the name of Christopher Vernon of the
 same place County and Province planter of the other part, And as
