

Obtained by the said Benj<sup>ts</sup> on the Judgmt<sup>ts</sup> afo<sup>re</sup> and whether any of his  
 Goods and Chattells of what Nature soever were by any means Executed  
 by the said Benj<sup>ts</sup> Bramos or any for him for the Satisfying his said  
 Judgmt<sup>ts</sup>. So as afo<sup>re</sup> obtained if not why the said Atkey should be  
 restored to the Tobacco which the said Coupl<sup>ts</sup> nor any for him ever  
 took from said Atkey, And that the said Atkey may further set  
 forth whether Nathaniel Wynson by Virtue of the said Writ of  
 Prostitution Attachment &c. Condemnation thereon did not take  
 out of the hands of Gilbert Southwold the Coupl<sup>ts</sup> factor for the  
 use of said John Atkey Seven thousand Six hundred & forty pounds  
 of Tobacco for the Costs and Charges of the said Atkey in Error &  
 to restore him to (as he to the Court falsely Alledged & Suggested was  
 taken in Execution from him) five thousand three hundred & thirty  
 Eight pounds of Tobacco for principall and Interest & Eight hundred  
 and thirty seven pounds of Tobacco Costs of Suit for which y<sup>e</sup> said  
 Coupl<sup>ts</sup> as afo<sup>re</sup> had Judgmt<sup>ts</sup> - what did the said Nathaniel Wynson  
 with the said Tobacco after he had taken it out of the hands of  
 the Coupl<sup>ts</sup> Factor whether he did not deliver it to said Atkey  
 or order if not to whom did he deliv<sup>r</sup> it And that the said Atkey  
 may be obliged to restore the said Seven thousand three hundred &  
 forty Six pounds of Tobacco so unduly obtained from the said Benj<sup>ts</sup>  
 with the Interest of the same from the time of taking thereof &  
 the said Benj<sup>ts</sup> further relieved in all and singular the premises  
 according to the Rules of Equity and good Conscience; - wherefore he  
 prays Sup<sup>er</sup> &c. - And the said John Atkey Answereth & saith that  
 he having about nine years agoe dealt with Cap<sup>t</sup> William Hoode  
 as factor to the Coupl<sup>ts</sup> for goods and Merchandises to the Value of  
 four thousand nine hundred and forty Eight pounds of Tob<sup>o</sup> as in  
 Bill set forth did pass his obligation to the Coupl<sup>ts</sup> therefore afo<sup>re</sup>  
 wards paid and satisfied the same to Gedion Pearce Account<sup>ts</sup>.
