

his will and desire to be that his said Children should Enjoy his said
 Personal Estate and that his principale motive to make the said
 Will was to Empower some person to sell part of his Real Estate to pay
 his Debts to the End that his then Personal Estate might remain clear
 to the Use of the said Minor and his Sisters a/c. That the said Testator after-
 wards viz on or about the first day of March 1701 dyed and the said Eliz.
 took upon her the Burthen of the Execution of the said Will and the Admⁿ
 of the Testators goods and Chattells and returned an Inventory and made up
 an Account thereof upon which Account there appears due to the said
 Testators Estate after the Deduction of the said Eliz. boths thirds thereof $217:2:11$
 of which the said Minors portion is $43:8:7$. That the said Eliz. well knowing
 the Intention of the said Testator, In compliance pursuance thereof and
 and in compliance with what she knew to be his true Intent meaning before
 her Inter marriage with the said Charles Gilburne did pay and Satisfy unto
 Eliz. the said Minors Sister the eldest of the said five Children in part of
 her portion of said Personal Estate to the Value of about Seven pound Sterl.
 That Eliz. the said after the said Testators decease married one Andrew Wolsey
 who also in pursuance of the Testators said Intentions always declared
 himself willing to pay to your Orat. and the said Children the full Residue
 as a/c of said Estate who being dead she afterwards Inter married with y.
 aforesaid Charles Gilburne. That the said Charles being also well
 Satisfied of the said Testators true Intent meaning by his will a/c did pay
 or Secure to be paid unto your Orat. and the said Eliz. y. daughter his wife
 the full residue of her portion a/c that the said Gilburne did always declare
 himself willing and ready to give Security to the said Minor & his other
 Sisters for their portions as usuall in such cases till he was by some ill minded
 people possessed with a belief that his wife the said Eliz. being left &c
 he might by colour thereof defraud the said Minor and his Sisters and keep
 the whole Estate to himself contrary to the true Intent and meaning of the
 said Testator. Now so it is may it please your hon. that the said Charles
 Gilburne having the whole Residue of the said Estate in his hands and being
 Induced by the persuasions of vile men to defraud the said Minor & his Sisters
 thereof
