Respecting this plantation to the South West whereon Peter Hoackers then lived and showed him this Deponent a bounded Circle marked with Two low Notches standing about fifteen yards North from the Cedar described in the plot at the Letter A and then told him it was his first bounded Tree and did further say that he had taken up a Slip of Land beginning also at the said Tree and running up the Creek, telling him this Depon. further how one William Taverner, who was his overseer had bid to have taken it up before him and this Depon. further saith that in the Cove on the upper Side of the said point his Landlord the said Howard being a fishing he lost a Gold Ring from of his finger, and after that they usually called that Cove the Ring Cove, and further this Deponent saith not.
