 England and was brought home to perogrine Browns house and was
 disposed on by the said Browne, and this Deponent further saith he was
 Surgeon on board the Ship Young Margarett and kept a Journale of the Transac-
 tions in reference to her Lading &c. and that said Capt Browne required this
 Deponent to fetch the said Tooth from on board of said Mann of Warr, and
 this Depon. afterwards saw the said Tooth Exposed to Sale by him and
 knows them to have been sold by him - But this Depon. cannot justly
