John Clements aged fifty three years or thereabouts deposes on the Holy Evangelist, that about thirty years since Francis Adams told this Deponent that the said Adams was with the Survey. & at first took up of Whites Ford now Aquonsock, and that about the time aforesaid mentioned this Depon. had sent some Sows and pigs & Enquiries of the said Adams all whom he told this Deponent that at such a place under the bounded Fee of M^r. White the said Sows and pigs had their beds, and this Depon. going by said Adams's Directions found the said Sows and pigs with their beds under this white Oaks Tree whereon he now lays his hand and the said Oaks stand at the South Corner of the said Moales now dwelling plain between two Springs being near it on each side one about thirty paces the other about thirty two paces from the said Fee, and further the said Adams told this Depon. that he the said Adams was ordered by Jst. Suro. to bound the said Fee, & further saith not.
