Coments past a Deed to her Said husband which was acknowledged in Court and brought to her Said husbands house (as she very well remembers) by Mr. Vaughan who was then Clerk of the County, & who delivered it to this Depo. which deed was burnt amongst other papers in this Depoents house about Twenty four years since, & further Saith not. -
