but of Late Low Branch, falls into the said River, the said Tree having  
been formerly Notched (viz. forty Eight Years ago or thereabouts as the  
Deponent avers) with Three or more Notches on the West Side (only)  
of said Tree; which to us and the Company present in part appeared so,  
and further saith not.
