Whereas by virtue of A writ of Mandamus to us directed Henry Adams & Ignatius  
 Causin from the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> Charles Lord & Proprietary of the Province of  
 Maryland & Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore & Chief are therefore in the name  
 of the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> the Lord Proprietary to Will & Command you that you Summons  
 Twelve good & lawfull men of Charles County by whom the truth of the matter may be  
 better known & Enquired of what Lands George Robinson Son of William  
 Robinson dyed seized of at the time of his death to Meet at the Plantation  
 formerly Mr Samuell Peoples on the twenty fourth day of this present month of  
 August And for yo<sup>r</sup> so doing this shall be yo<sup>r</sup> warrant Given under our hands  
 & Seals this Ninth day of August One thousand six hundred Seventy six
