 of Potomack Creek containing by Estimation One hundred & fifty Acres  
 or other heirs of William Robinson deceased (as we find according  
 to best information we can gett But of what Mannor & under what Rents  
 & Services the said Land is hold We Jurors are altogether ignorant and  
 further We Jurors as We humbly conceive that the said One hundred and  
 fifty Acres of Land are of Value by the Year in all Issues four  
 hundred pounds of Tobacco and further We Jurors upon our Oathes say  
 that the said George Robinson son of William Robinson dyed (vizt) on  
 the twenty sixth day of January Anno Domini One thousand six hundred  
 seventy six that he dyed seized of the said tract of Land  
 and of his in the County of Charles without any heirs or Will and further  
 We Jurors find that the said Land since the death of the said  
 George Robinson son of William Robinson was in the possession of  
 Samuel Copley who married the Heir of the said William Robinson  
 one day and since the death of the said Samuel Copley the said  
 Land hath been in the possession of Richard Edlin exec of the said  
 Samuel Copley deceased In witness whereof as well the Commissioners as  
 the Jurors aforesaid have hereunto sett their hands & seals the day  
 & year first above written

Which being Read & heard it is the Judgment of the Court here  
 the Nine & Twentieth day of November One thousand six hundred &  
 seventy six that the Land in this Inquisition named is granted to  
 his Excellency & Lord Proprietary for one of his heirs

We whose names are here underwritten being a Jury of Enquiry of  
 a parcel of land lying on the North side of Sassafox River where  
 the Court house now stands who is the Right owner thereof & how much  
 the same contains & who there was possessor of the same & by what  
 title & how & in what manner they had held & enjoyed the same  
 The Inquisition of which we here returne our Proceedings: That is this  
 parcel of land was taken up by Francis Smith and sold to John  
 Brown of New England & sold to the said Brown to Margard Seaver  
 a Swede & sold from the said Seaver to Peter Jacobson a Swede  
 who dyed & left it to his son Jeffrey Peterse who held it after the  
 death of his father only by this note here under written being the true  
 Coppy which is all the title he held the said Land by  
 Know all men by these presents that I John Brown of New England Mariner  
 have sold & delivered unto Margard Seaver the fifty Acres of Land lying  
 on the point on the North side of Sassafox River bounding on the Creek of  
 Burdicks Land on the one side & on Coofings Creeke on the other side  
 called by the name of Youngs Park with all the priviledges belonging to it  
 for
