 Lord One thousand six hundred seventy five in the Tenth Year  
 of the Dominion of Carliul & before us John Douglas & Robert Downe  
 by Vertue of A Commission in the nature of A writ of Mandamus to us  
 Directed Also the said Inquisition charged to Enquire what Land  
 John Legatt late of Charlts County aforesaid dyed seized of at the  
 time of his Death as of free in the said County & of what Name  
 under what Rents or services & how much those Lands & Tenements was  
 of Value by the Year in all Shires & at what time the said John  
 Legatt dyed & who is his next heire & of what Age the heire is  
 & who those Lands & Tenements from the time of the death of the  
 said John Legatt have or doth Occupy & the Shires or profits hath or  
 doth Receive & by what Title & how & in what manner & who hath paid  
 the Rent for the same & to whom as in the Mandamus By the  
 Oathes of Thomas Lomax Richard Ambrose Samuell Stark Robert  
 Portant Walter Davids William Hinson James Tyce Thomas Wakefield  
 John Norton John Pearson Thomas Phipsham & John Broome the  
 Jury Impanelled by the Sheriffe of Charlts County doe upon their  
 oathes say as followeth: That William Smooke being seized in  
 his Demourne as of free in A parcel of Land lying on the West  
 side of Winton Road Beginning at A Marked Oak the Corner  
 betwixt John Hattheds Land & bounding on the East with A line drawn  
 North & by West from the said Oak for the length of two hundred  
 Perches to an Oak standing neare the land of John Court On the  
 North with A line drawn West & by South from the End of the former  
 line for the length of three hundred & twenty Perches to A Marked  
 Red Oak standing upon the Road of the Branch called Smooth Branch till  
 it intersect A Parallel line drawn from the said Hattheds Oak on  
 the South with the said Parallel Containing now said Out for four  
 hundred Acres be it more or less By Vertue of A Grant under the  
 Great Seale of this Countie to him thereof Granted bearing date the  
 Twentieth day of June in the Year of Our Lord One thousand  
 six hundred fifty two to be holden of us Lord Proprie  
 as of his Manor of West S Marges under the yearly Rent of eight  
 Shillings Sterling & thence he the said William Smooke did upon the  
 Twentieth day of May One thousand six hundred fifty six Assigne all his  
 Right in the Premises unto Humphrey Atwicks & Richard Smooke which  
 Assignement was in Open Court in Charlts County aforesaid Acknowledged  
 by the said William Smooke & Grace his wife & the said Richard Smooke  
 did upon the eighth day of June One thousand six hundred fifty six  
 his Right & Title of the within Mentioned taken unto Thomas  
 Mitchell & his Assignes And the said Thomas Mitchell upon the  
 third day of May One thousand six hundred fifty nine did  
 make Over from him & his Assignes all his Right & Title & interest  
 of the said Patent unto the said Humphrey Atwicks his heires or Assignes  
 And the said Humphrey Atwicks being seized & Possessed of the
